Discounts

Sibling/Family: 10% discount on additional students monthly tuition, highest students hours are billed first.

Semester In Full: 5% discount applied to your total bill if you pay the semester in full (Fall = 4 monthly payments, Spring = 5 monthly payments)

Competition

Students/parents will be billed separately for all competition choreography, additional rehearsals and entry fees.

Fees will be sent as a pre-payment plan. Parents will have the option to opt out of the pre-payment plan and pay per event bulk payments. Detailed information will be sent/discussed with each competitive family prior to pre-payment invoices being sent.

Policies

There is a one-time \$25 registration fee per student or \$40 per family due once registration is received to save your students spot.

Monthly invoices (with the exception of the first month) will be sent out the 25th of each month and are due by the 1st of the following month. Payments made after the 5th are considered late and a \$15 late fee will be automatically added.

Class schedule is based on 35 weeks of instruction with payment broken into 9 months of equal payment.

When dropping a class, a written notice must be received prior to the 25th. If no notice is provided before this date, you will be responsible for the full tuition payment. We do not offer refunds for dropped classes but will offer account credits for any months tuition remaining after the drop effective date.

An auto-payment option will be available starting with October invoices. Information will be sent out to all registered students in September.

CLASSROOM ETIQUETTE & DRESS CODE

Classroom/Studio Etiquette

Students under the age of 10 will be escorted into and out of the studio by an instructor or assistant.

Parents should meet students in the lobby promptly upon conclusion of their class.

Students cell phones must be put away while class is in session. Smart watches may be worn but will be asked to be removed if students are visibly distracted by their use.

Parents are not permitted in studios without permission from the instructor.

No photos or audio/video recording of any type is permitted in the classroom by parents or students. Students/parents are not permitted to post photos/videos of other students or faculty members to social media without permission of all individuals.

No food or drink with the exception of water is permitted within the studios.

For the safety of the student and to avoid disruption of class education, students who are over 10 minutes late to class should warm-up quietly in the hallway and only enter the studio when they are able to fully participate in class. Students who are over 30 minutes late to class may be asked to remain in the hallway until their next class begins.

If parents wish to speak to a teacher, they must first reach out via email or speak to the front desk to determine an appropriate time for a conversation. Teachers will not be able to have discussions with parents during or after class to keep on their teaching schedule.

BCPA reserves the right to suspend any student/family for failure to adhere to any of the policies stated.

Dress Code Policy

Female students: a leotard and tights must be worn during all dance classes. A ballet skirt may be added during ballet, and tight fitting shorts/leggings may be added during tap/jazz. T-shirts, sweatpants, and other loose fitting clothes are not permitted unless otherwise told by instructor.

Male students: plain t-shirts, solid shorts or sweatpants. Graphic t-shirts are not permitted.

Shoes: Students must have the appropriate class shoe for all classes. Shoes and other dancewear may be purchased through the studio but this is not required. See the front desk for questions or further details regarding brand/color/style recommendation.

Hair must be secured tightly and neatly out of the students face.

For the safety of the student, necklaces, bracelets, dangling earrings, etc are not permitted. Earring jewelry must be studs and tightly secured with backing.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Missed Class Policy

Students are able to make-up a missed class due to illness or weather related issue by attending a class that is at the same level or one level below their current level. Please reach out to the front desk to determine an appropriate make-up time. Students must get teacher permission before attending a make-up class. There are no refunds for missed classes.

Weather Policy

Our studio follows the weather policies of the Butler Area School District (BASD). If the BASD calls for a cancellation or early dismissal, the studio will be closed for that day. In the event of a cancellation, make-up classes will be offered prior to the end of the semester.

Please be sure to check your email, WPXI closings/cancellations, and BCPA social media for updates during inclement weather.

Performance Policy

Students are encouraged but not required to participate in BCPA produced shows. Students who choose to participate are required to be in attendance for all rehearsals and performances at the studio and venue.

All BCPA students are required to enter and exit through the theater stage door with a parent/guardian. The parent/guardian must check in/out their student with the BCPA staff.

All students must remain backstage for the entire performance. Supervision will be provided.

A video recording of each show will be professionally produced for purchase. For the safety of all students, no photos or videos may be personally recorded during events.

There is no performance fee for students to participate in any BCPA production.

All BCPA shows are held at BC3 Succop Theater with reserved seating. Ticket sale information will be made available approx 2-3 months prior to each show.

Competition Policy

Students interested in competitive dance must see the front desk for an individualized assessment prior to signing up/being placed in competitive groups.

Students who have committed to a competitive group must be enrolled and have good attendance in the technique class for the competitive style.

Students who miss more than 3 of the same technique class may be removed from sections of a dance. A parent/student/teacher discussion will take place prior to any changes being made to the choreography.

Parents are responsible for all additional competition, costume, choreography fees and must be up to date on their monthly tuition to participate in competitions.
